### 1. Observation Paper—Due every Tuesday and Friday at 5:00 p.m.

The primary work of the class will be for the student to look carefully at selected texts of Scripture and the Spirit of Prophecy and then write a two page reflection paper structured in the following way:

#### Page One: Double Spaced.

**Observations:** Carefully note down all the items you observed about the text.

##### *Example: Psalms 1:*

It is the first Psalm in the Bible.

The Psalm begins with the word “Blessed.”

The word “way” is used three times.

#### Page Two:

**Interpretation/Meaning:** Now give a one-half page summary about what you have observed:

##### *Example: Psalms 1:*

This Psalm talks about two different types of people who either chose the way of the wicked or the way of the righteous.

**Personal Application:** Now give a one-half page summary how the study of the text has or will affect your life and ministry:

##### *Example: Psalms 1:*

I need to take more time to meditate upon the word of the Lord.

### 2. Article Report—Due every Monday and Wednesday at the beginning of class.

Write a one page book report on the weekly reading assignment by answering these two basic questions:

What was the central message of the article?

How can the article be applied to your life and ministry?
